Motion by S Lange, second by A Lange to approve **Resolution 17-21 approving the 2017 Fiscal Year Street Finance Report.** Roll Call: Ayes – S Lange, B Hemann, J Hemann, A Lange; Nays – 0. Motion carried.

Motion by S Lange, second by B Hemann to approve a building permit for Lynn Dahling at 203 E Morrison to cement a driveway over a portion of sanitary sewer on city alley (pending an Agreement between the City of Edgewood and Lynn Dahling regarding responsibility for replacement of driveway if needed in the future). Roll Call: Ayes – J Hemann, A Lange, S Lange, B Hemann; Nays – 0. Motion carried.
